1. Central Park

- 1. Playground We reviewed the updated playground designs from Midwest Playscapes and Landscape Structures. Overall, we like the design from Landscape Structures better. Tim will ask Bailey if she can render some different color combinations in the current design. We are comfortable moving forward with Landscape Structures.
- 2. Dugout Shelters The Baseball Association is asking for 4 brick dugout shelters. Adam suggested a cantilever design instead, but this will not protect from the elements quite as much. The committee would like to explore options of a tin design similar to that of the dugouts at the high school baseball field. We also discussed asking the Baseball Association for more of a substantial donation to help cover the costs. Advertising on the dugout was also discussed. The committee is going to explore more options.
- **3. Hockey Rink** We discussed the potential of moving the hockey rink, but it seems as though it is in the best possible spot.
- **4. Youth Baseball/Softball Advertising** No further updates.
